

NJSLA-Science Testing Schedule
May 30-31, 2018

Per the New Jersey Department of Education, all 11th grade students, regardless of the science course they are taking during the 2017-2018 school year, are required to take the NJSLA-Science Assessment. Burlington Township HS will be administering the NJSLA-S on May 30th and 31st. The NJSLA-S is aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards. Your student's participation in this assessment is important for our district. The information we receive from our student test results will help us to review how well our curriculum is addressing the new science standards and what revisions we may need to make in our curriculum. We appreciate your cooperation in making sure your student participates in the assessment.

On Wednesday, May 30th and Thursday, May 31st, all 11th grade students should report to school at the regular time to take the NJSLA-S Assessment. Students in grades 9, 10, and 12 should arrive at their bus stop 2 hours and 40 minutes later than their normal time and report to the following locations when they arrive at school:
