

2017 PSAT Information for Students and Parents

The PSAT will be administered at Burlington Township this year on Wednesday, October 11th. **All juniors** have been registered to take the PSAT, and the cost of the test will be covered by the district. The PSAT is closely aligned with the SAT. This is an excellent opportunity to get a glimpse of into the types of questions that are asked on the SAT. Taking the PSAT will also provide students with numerous free test preparation resources through the College Board. Juniors should report to school at the regular time on October 11th. Testing will begin promptly at 7:20.

If they wish, students in grades 9 and 10 may sign up to take the PSAT. Students in grades 9 and 10 must sign up in the Counseling Office in either building by Thursday, October 5th. The fee for the PSAT for 9th and 10th graders is \$16- checks are preferred and should be made out to BTHS. Students who qualify for free/reduced lunch may have this fee waived.

Seniors who have not yet met their state testing requirements may also sign up for the PSAT- see your counselor or one of the Counseling Office secretaries. Students taking the PSAT will report to school at the regular time on October 11th. **Please note that this is the only opportunity to take the PSAT at BTHS this year.**

Seniors and any freshmen or sophomores who are not testing will be on a **special** delayed opening schedule. You should report to your bus stop **2 hours and 40 minutes later** than the normal pickup time.
