Dear Parents and Guardians,

Burlington Township High School will be operating on a delayed opening December 4th- 11th. We will be administering the PARCC tests to **all students enrolled in a first semester** Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, English 1, English 2, and English 3 course. Students in the Class of 2018 and 2019 are required to pass the PARCC or one of the other tests listed below. Students in the Class of 2020 may also use one of the tests listed below, provided that they take all PARCC exams they are eligible for. Students in the Class of 2021 are required to pass the PARCC exams in Algebra 1 and ELA 10. We want all of our students to be eligible to graduate on time and therefore taking the PARCC test is imperative. In addition, some community colleges are now using the PARCC scores for entrance.

SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing-450; SAT Math-440
ACT- 16 on Reading and Math
ACT Aspire- 422 on the reading and math
ASVAB-AFQT 31 on the reading and math
Accuplacer- Write Placer 6
Accuplacer- Math 76
PARCC- ELA 9 and 10-750, ELA 11-725; Algebra 1- 750, Algebra 2 and Geometry- 725
PSAT Reading sub-score-22; PSAT math sub-score- 22
Meet the criteria of the NJDOE Portfolio Appeal in English Language Arts and Math

The ELA PARCC exams will be given from Monday-Wednesday, Dec. 4th-6th and the Math PARCC exams will be given Thursday, Friday, and Monday, Dec. 7th, 8th, and 11th. Only students taking those exams should report to school on time. Students not enrolled in these classes during the first semester will report to school for a 10:00am start time.
