Dear Parents and Guardians,

Burlington Township High School will be operating on a delayed opening the week of May 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, and 22nd. We will be administering the PARCC tests to students enrolled in semester 2 or full-year courses in Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, English 1, English 2, and English 3. Students in the Class of 2017 and beyond will be required to pass the PARCC or one of the other tests listed below. Students in the Class of 2020 are required to take all PARCC exams in order to use one of the tests listed below for their graduation requirement. We want all of our students to be eligible to graduate on time and therefore taking the PARCC test is imperative. In addition, some community colleges are now using the PARCC scores for as an entrance requirement.

PARCC ELA Grade 9 or 10- 750 or above, PARCC ELA 11- 725 or above
PARCC Algebra 1- 750 or above, PARCC Algebra 2 or Geometry- 725 or above
SAT Reading- Evidenced Based Reading and Writing 450 or above or SAT Reading Test- 22 or above
SAT Math Section- 440 or above or SAT Math Test 22 or above
ACT- 16 on Reading and Math
ACT Aspire- 422 on the reading and math
ASVAB-AFQT 31 on the reading and math
Accuplacer- Write Placer 6
Accuplacer- Math 76
PSAT Reading and PSAT Math- 22 or above
Meet the criteria of the NJDOE Portfolio Appeal in English Language Arts and Math

The math PARCC exams will be given on Monday-Wednesday, May 15th-17th and the English PARCC exams will be given Thursday-Monday, May 18th-22nd. Only students taking those exams should report to school on time. Students not scheduled for a PARCC exam will report to school for a 10:00am start time.
