Our school is required to comply with the State mandated security procedures which include monthly drills. We also may participate in the district emergency management safety plan. A number of drills may require police presence. Throughout the year, police, emergency responders, and administrators will coordinate the various drills to be practiced which may include: lockdown, lockout, shelter in place, fire drill or evacuation. Every month we are required to practice two drills. The purpose of the safety and security drills are discussed with the students and practiced prior to the actual drill. All staff members provide assistance in the supervision and coordination of every drill.

We practiced a fire and evacuation drill where students were safely escorted out of the building to designated areas. As the weather is changing, and drills are mandated for us to practice, please ensure students wear appropriate attire for outside. The children always do a great job because everyone works as a team to practice safety.
